**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF GYPSUM, COLORADO, CANCELING THE
APRIL 2, 2024 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the Town of Gypsum, Colorado ("Town") is a home rule municipality duly organized and existing under Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the Town's Home Rule Charter effective October 21, 1982 ("Charter"); and

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council ("Council") are duly elected, chosen and qualified at general municipal elections held on the first Tuesday following the first Monday of April in each even numbered year, in accordance with the Charter, which general election was to be held on April 2, 2024; and

WHEREAS, nomination petitions to be a candidate for such Election were filed no later than the 71st day prior to the Election, pursuant to Section 31-10-302(2), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, no affidavits of intent to be a write-in candidate for such election were filed by the 64th day before the election, pursuant to Section 31-10-912, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31-10-507, C.R.S., if there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the Election, the governing body shall cancel the election and by resolution declare the candidates elected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GYPSUM, COLORADO, that:

1. There were not more candidates than offices to be filled at the election; therefore, pursuant to Section 31-10-507, C.R.S., the general municipal election to be conducted on April 2, 2024 is hereby cancelled.

2. The following candidates are declared elected to the four-year terms expiring in 2028:

Tom Edwards
Chris Huffman

3. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its approval by the District Board.
