WHEREAS, warmer temperatures, drought, and continued development in the wildland-urban interface have made wildfire mitigation a top priority for The Town of Gypsum and surrounding jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Gypsum has determined the goals of wildfire risk reduction, wildfire preparedness and public education; and that collaboration in these areas will lead to unified and fire-adapted communities throughout The Town of Gypsum and surrounding jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Wildfire Preparedness Month is focused on encouraging residents to learn about wildfire safety and take steps to reduce wildfire risk in and around their homes; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned desire to join in support of Wildfire Preparedness Month and to designate May 2025 as Wildfire Preparedness Month in Eagle County, the participating Towns, and the participating Fire Districts, as outlined in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE TOWN OF GYPSUM, COLORADO THAT MAY 2025 IS WILDFIRE PREPAREDNESS MONTH.
