RESOLUTION NO. 22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INTEGRATED PROJECT DELIVERY

- A. The Town of Gypsum, Colorado ("Town") is a home rule municipality organized and existing under Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the Town's Home Rule Charter effective October 21, 1982; and
- B. The Town may award contracts for public improvements on a "best value" rather than "lowest responsible, responsive bid" basis as allowed by the Integrated Delivery Method for Public Projects Act; and
- C. The Gypsum Town Council ("Town Council") has reviewed and considered the various challenges and opportunities relevant to the delivery of **Highway 6 Segment 1 design AND I-70 Eagle Airport Interchange planning and design** ("Project"), including but not limited to the following:
 - 1. Potential to become federally funded and be compliant with the Brooks Act; and
 - 2. Continuity of the various parties involved in the Project from start to finish which increases efficiency; and
 - 3. Leveraging the most qualified firms to complete the work rather than solely the lowest cost; and
 - 4. Maximizing collaboration between design professionals, contractors, and the Town throughout the Project; and
 - 5. Minimizing probability of adversarial relationships and legal issues; and
 - 6. Time and/or money savings by integration of budget, schedule, and constructability of the project from the outset; and
 - 7. Ability to fast-track design and construction and/or utilize concurrent design and construction phases for different segments of the project; and
 - 8. Greater focus on quality control and quality assurance through all phases of the project.
- D. The Council hereby finds and determines that integrated project delivery represents a timely and cost-effective alternative for delivery of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GYPSUM, STATE OF COLORADO THAT:

- 1. <u>Authority to Use Integrated Project Delivery</u>. The Town Council hereby finds and determines that integrated project delivery represents a timely and cost-effective alternative for the Project.
- 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect on and be enforced starting October 15, 2025.
